





## 5. Principal's Report

Our new outdoor learning environment consists of a dry creek bed, a bridge, 3 platforms, a canoe, a goanna, stepping stones, seating and boat. This will be a passive play area. DET have approved all aspects of the outdoor learning environment. Several plants have been added to add another element. There a couple of things we were not happy with - this has delayed things a little and they have to move a few plants. 1 platform had no railing and is near rocks - this will be rectified. Kids are really excited by the boats and platforms.

Tree inspection - another tree inspection was conducted and a few branches will be trimmed. This will cost about \$4000. We have spent approximately \$18,000 so far this year on the trees.

Community grant - One of the community grants we have applied for required a sketch of the proposed works. The same landscaper who did the outdoor learning environment will come and create a design for the Ruby Road upgrade.

Chaplin - The 3 yr contract is up for Jesse Morsen. Applications are now being taken. We will find out next term if we get a chaplain again. We are hoping so as we see the benefits for the school community.

Pavers - Cane from Amber came out to find the best place for the pavers. He believes the entrance to the office block is the most appropriate and effective use of the pavers. We will cut out the existing slab and lay named and blank pavers. This will lead straight up to the office door. Final decision has been made now, Cane will come back and measure. We still need to buy blanks and figure labour cost. SR is on the case.

Fathers Day breakfast went really well. It took more staff than anticipated. Potentially RSVP for next time. 260 bacon and egg rolls were sold. Next time we will start cooking earlier. This event led into the fathering project. 7 dads turned up to the information night. It went well. SR is positive about the project. Great opportunity for fathers to meet fathers regardless of what year their children are in. We all believe this is important for the future. The 1st father and children event will be in term 4. Week 5 - 14th November (Thursday). Pizza and planes. There will be an RSVP system. The fathering project has small cost that school covers. There is also a small cost per events.
